



Young Inventor Challenge Project Checklist

If you plan to come to Chicago to compete in person, your entry must contain the following:

- I have registered for the event
- I have paid my entry fee
- I have answered all of the questions in the Registration Portal
- I have uploaded 3 photos that show off my prototype to the Registration Portal
- I have uploaded my Pitch Video to YouTube, Vimeo, Google Drive, etc
- I have shared the video link in the Registration Portal
- I have double checked that that my video's privacy settings are set so that the Mentors can see it.
- I have had my parent/guardian read the permissions and they have electronically signed the agreement in the portal

If you plan to come to Chicago to compete in person, your entry must contain the following:

- Your Poster Display needs to contain
 - Student Name
 - Project Name
 - Student Age and Grade
 - Student City and State
 - Brainstorming/Development: summarize the process you went through to develop your game/toy.
 - Game Testing: Who did you play your game with? What was their feedback? Did you make changes/adjustments based on this?
 - Rules or Instructions for your toy or game
 - Marketing Message: to persuade your target audience about why they should buy your toy/game. You may want to create a slogan or consider listing the benefits and unique features of your invention.
 - Credits for people who helped you
- Your Prototype
- Your logbook so we can see how your ideas developed!
